## Over the past 15 years, PeaceHealth has invested more than \$1 billion in Lane County, and we only plan to continue.

### Recent and future investments include:



**\$1.25M** donation and **partnership with Eugene YMCA** to improve health outcomes in Lane County.



The development of the **PeaceHealth Oregon Institute for Nursing Excellence (INE)** to support nurses in caring for patients and the long-range development of their careers.



Investment in new imaging equipment for Florence and Cottage Grove communities.



Renovation of the Rehabilitation Center in Florence.



Continued investments in Bushnell's and Lane County Community College's Nursing and Respiratory Therapy programs to address current staffing challenges.



Plans to open new clinics, including a new pediatrics plus clinic at Valley River and a new family medicine clinic in Pleasant Hill.



Creation of a new and expanded vascular surgery group.



**Addition of Northwest Surgical Specialists to PeaceHealth Medical Group** to expand our shared legacy of exceptional surgical care in Oregon.



**\$80M** investment in a new **50-bed inpatient rehab facility** in partnership with LifePoint Health, offering the region's first traumatic brain injury unit.



Ongoing capital investments at RiverBend in critical advanced services only PeaceHealth provides, such as open-heart surgery, cardiac procedures, advanced stroke care, and regional trauma services.
